Learn how to harvest your own **grass-fed, non-GMO, free-range, organic, and anti-biotic free** upland game birds. AND how to eat them!

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is offering an opportunity for adults to learn how to hunt, harvest, and cook wild upland birds in the Antigo, WI area. Participants will learn how to hunt, clean, cook, and sample wild game in an adult learning environment. Participants and mentors will have opportunities to share locally harvested foods throughout the class. All necessary equipment will be provided.

Class dates are April 19, 23, May 1, 2, and a pheasant hunt will be held on May 12. Then, in September, participants will get to hunt for wild ruffed grouse with mentors.
